

TAX COLLECTOR

The 2010 Central Dauphin School District Real Estate Tax bills will be mailed by the district by July 1, 2010. Call me if you do not receive the bill by July 8th.

The discount amounts are good through August 31st. My extended hours for August are on your bill. If you are paying in three installments, the first installment MUST be received by me by AUGUST 15th.

Please call if you would like to come to pay your bill at another time than my regular hours. When mailing a payment, please proofread your check before mailing it. Most errors are made on the written numerical amount.

The school district is requiring that I open a separate account for their payments. Therefore, if you are paying both tax bills at one time, I will need separate checks. Call me if you have any questions.

STORM WATER PROTECTION

With springtime comes increased outdoor activities and home improvements. Please consider the runoff from your project or activity and how it may impact the storm water which enters our streams.

Home Repair and Improvement

- Before beginning an outdoor project, locate the nearest storm drains and protect them from debris and other materials.
- Sweep up and properly dispose of construction debris such as concrete and mortar.
- Use hazardous substances like paints, solvents, and cleaners in the smallest amounts possible, and follow the directions on the label. Clean up spills immediately, and dispose of the waste safely. Store substances properly to avoid leaks and spills.
- Purchase and use nontoxic, biodegradable, recycled, and recyclable products whenever possible.
- Clean paint brushes in a sink, not outdoors. Filter and reuse paint thinner when using oil-based paints. Properly dispose of excess paints through a household hazardous waste collection program, or donate unused paint to local organizations.
- Reduce the amount of paved area and increase the amount of vegetated area in your yard. Use native plants in your landscaping to reduce the need for watering during dry periods. Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces and onto lawns and consider other measures to increase infiltration and reduce polluted runoff.
